Caliber Collision's Summer Food Drive Delivers Over 172,000 Meals across California, Arizona, Nevada and Texas

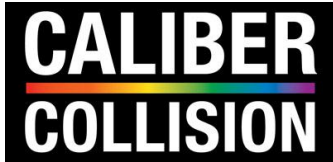
**22,000 Food Items, \$5,400 Cash Donations and \$26,871 in
Matching Contributions to Local Food Banks**

DALLAS, TX, July 23, 2012 – Overflowing collection bins from a simultaneous two-week food drive throughout Caliber Collision Centers in California, Arizona, Nevada and Texas have resulted in 22,000 food items, \$5,400 in cash donations, and a matching corporate contribution of \$26,871 for local food banks.

According to representatives of the food banks, the combined food and cash contributions translate into approximately 172,000 additional meals that the organizations can provide for local families this summer. Caliber Collision's Rhythm Restoration Food Drive was an employee-driven effort with Caliber pledging to match \$1 for each food item and dollar donated.

"This contribution comes at an extremely critical time during summer months when donations slow down but the need to feed many families does not," said Carole Tremblay, Chief Development Officer of the Los Angeles Regional Food Bank, one of the many organizations that benefitted from Caliber's food drive.
