Local Businesses Thank and Honor Veteran for Service through Donation of Recycled Rides Vehicle

Owning a car would have been as alien as "getting to the moon," says local National Guard veteran.


LEWISVILLE, TX – February 23, 2012 – For many veterans, returning homeand assimilating back into civilian life is sometimes a struggle. As a way to thank and honor their service, Lewisville-based Caliber Collision Centers and GEICO Insurance have teamed up through a nationwide program called Recycled Rides to donate a refurbished vehicle to a local Dallas-area veteran.

John Jones and his family will be presented with keys and title to a 2006 Toyota Camry on February 28, 1:00 pm, at Caliber Collision's Keller Center on 1725 S. Main St.

Diagnosed with post traumatic syndrome and suffering from a back injury, Jones has been unable to work since returning home to Dallas in August 2011 after two back-to-back tours of duty in Iraq. Jones, his wife and two children, ages 13 and 10, currently live with his sister and rely on family for support during this difficult time. Lack of transportation has been particularly difficult due to frequent visits to doctors and everyday requirements of school-aged children.

With limited financial resources, buying a car at this point in their lives would be as alien as "getting to the moon," according to Jones, but having a car will be a "gigantic step to making us feel like a normal family again."

Jones was nominated for the Recycled Rides vehicle by ReserveAid, a nonprofit organization that provides assistance to military families with a Reservist or National Guard member on full time deployment or who has recently returned from deployment.

Later this week, on Friday, March 2, Caliber's Round Rock Center will present a Recycled Rides vehicle to Family Promise, whose mission is to help homeless and low-income families achieve sustainable independence.
