SACRAMENTO, CA (June 23, 2014) – A local U.S. Army veteran determined to rebuild his life after several years of being homeless and jobless has been selected to receive a newly refurbished vehicle as part of a Caliber Collision's Recycled Rides program.

Caliber Collision's Recycled Rides program partners with insurance companies to refurbish and donate vehicles to individuals in need. Nationwide Insurance donated the vehicle which was refurbished by Caliber associates who volunteered personal time to repair the vehicles as a way to give back to the communities they serve.

Hector Ponce had hit rock bottom when he first came to the Sacramento Veterans Resource Center for help. He was estranged from his family without a job or place to live. According to case managers who nominated him for the Recycled Rides vehicle, once Hector enrolled in the program, he immediately began doing everything in his power to turn his life around. After facing a tough economy and bleak job market, he recently was offered a part time catering position.

Hector has also reunited with his family and endures a grueling five-hour commute by light rail, bus and train, from Sacramento to San Jose, to visit his family. According to Hector, his ultimate goal is to give his family the support that has been lacking for many years.
