Car Donation to Help Struggling Army Veteran Get Back On the Road

DENVER, CO – September 22, 2014 – Caliber Collision is teaming up with Travelers to help a U.S. Army veteran who has fallen on hard times get back on the road by providing him with a newly refurbished vehicle as part of its nationwide Recycled Rides program. The vehicle unveiling will be at 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 24, at the Caliber Collision center in Littleton, Colorado, 5022 S. Jellison Way.

Richard Conley joined the Army in 1965 when he was 17. He served his six-year enlistment as an intelligence and security specialist. After leaving the Army, Richard enjoyed a successful career as a pilot for corporations including General Motors, federal contractors and state and local police SWAT units. His responsibilities ranged from flying VIPS in jets to dealing with hostage and crisis negotiation. About 10 years ago, he began to suffer from a series of medical conditions, including cancer and liver disease which took a toll on him both physically and financially.
