# Local Businesses Jump Start Holiday Season with Gift of Transportation to a Wounded Warrior

**STERLING, Va (December 2, 2015)** – The holiday giving season started early this year for a wounded warrior recovering at Ft. Belvoir from injuries suffered while on active duty in Afghanistan.

As a thank you for his service to our country, Tim Goodrich was presented today with keys to a newly refurbished 2013 Toyota Sienna minivan from Caliber Collision in Sterling and GEICO as part of the National Auto Body Council's Recycled Rides<sup>TM</sup> program.

Recycled Rides is a nationwide community service program in which collision repair companies, insurers and others in the collision industry collaborate to repair and donate vehicles to families in need. GEICO donated the vehicle and technicians at Caliber Collision donated their personal time as a community service.

Goodrich suffered severe leg injuries, a shattered jaw and traumatic brain injury in a rocket explosion in Afghanistan in February this year and is expected to be medically retired next month. Transportation has been a major concern for the family. Their current vehicle, a 2000 Ford Explorer with high mileage and in constant need of expensive repairs, is not reliable and not large enough to accommodate Tim, his wife Jacqueline, two young daughters in car seats, and soon, a service dog for Tim. In addition, with his leg injuries, riding in a small vehicle is uncomfortable and painful for Tim.

"At Caliber Collision, our highest purpose is to restore our customers and the communities we serve to the rhythm of their lives. We are honored to provide this vehicle to ease the burden of transportation for Tim and his family and wish him well with his recovery and transition back into civilian life," said Paul Krauss, Caliber Collision Vice President of Operations.

Goodrich was nominated for the Recycled Rides vehicle by Operation Homefront which helps provide emergency financial and other assistance to the families of service members and wounded warriors.
