Local Law Enforcement Officer, Military Service Members to Receive Surprise Vehicle Donations at Salute Our Heroes Concert

DALLAS, TX (October 19, 2016) -- Three Dallas-area law enforcement and military service members will be attending the "Salute to Heroes Concert" featuring Gary Sinese and the Lt. Dan Band this Friday, October 21, they are unaware they will be called up on stage and surprised with keys to practically brand new vehicles.

The vehicles are being presented by Caliber Collision, a sponsor of the 14th Annual American Airlines Sky Ball in support of the Airpower Foundation, founded by the nation's oldest military support organization, The Fort Worth Airpower Council.
